
CREEPY CRAWLIES


THESE ANIMALS HAVE EXOSKELETONS. TAP YOUR FOREHEAD, ELBOW AND KNEE. FEEL YOUR BONES UNDER YOUR SKIN? ARTHROPODS HAVE AN EXOSKELETON, THEIR STURDY PARTS ARE ON THE OUTSIDE, LIKE A SUIT OF ARMOR! OTHER ANIMALS WITH BACKBONES, LIKE US, ARE CALLED VERTEBRATES!

EXOSKELETONS ARE MADE OF CHITIN! THEY
ALSO HAVE SEGMENTS AND JOINTED LEGS. HOW
MANY KNEES DOES A TARANTULA HAVE? 48!!!






Some insects

SPIDER SNACK



Materials: Thin Pretzel Sticks, Cookie or Cracker Sandwiches
